REGULATIONS

The competitions will be held in accordance with Sport and Organization Rules and Referee Rules of the Asian Ju-Jitsu Belt Wrestling Federation (AJJBWF)

1-WEIGHT CATEGORIES (JU-JITSU) (FIGHTING SYSTEM)

2-ENTRIES

The number of entries permitted is limited:

- 2.1 Each National Federation may enter **ONE** competitor in each of the weight categories, i.e. a total of 13 (8-weight categories for Men and 05 for Women). In Ju-Jitsu competition, other than DUO System. The National Federation can nominate a single athlete for fighting in DUO, or can send separate name for DUO competition.
- 2.2 Four participants from four different countries must compete in a category in order that the championship for that category to be held.
- 2.3 Competitors may only be entered in the weight category to which they belong with the exception in Ju-Jitsu DUO System.

- 2.4 Participant can only be entered in one weight category in BW and NF may send 07 weight categories for men and 04 for women.
- 2.5 Only the names of the fighters duly entered following the above procedure will be drawn.
- 2.6. The NF which has both sports together can enter the same athlete in one weight category for both sports.

3-NATIONALITY

Competitors must be of the same nationality as the National Federation, which has entered them. Proof of nationality will be required according to the Sport and Organization Rules of the AJJBWF.

4-WEIGH IN

- * The weigh-in will be carried out in accordance with Sport and Organization Rules of the AJJBWF.
- * The weigh-in will be conducted on the same day that each respective category is being contested.
- * The competitors shall weigh-in wearing only gymnastic underclothing or naked, under the supervision of a weigh-in official of the same gender; the competitors may be requested to remove their underclothing to ensure they are within the prescribed limits of the weight category in which they are entered.
- * Only one weight control shall be permitted to each competitor up on the scale during the official weigh-in period.
- * No tolerance shall be allowed either above or below the weight category.

4.1 The weigh-in will be under the control of the Sports and Refereeing Directors.

4.2 Each competitor will bring to the weigh-in his or her AJJBWF control card.

5-GI- CONTROL

- 5.1** The gi Control will be under the control of the AJJBWF Sports Director.
- 5.2 Advertising:** Each national Federation has to make sure that the **marketing and advertising** placed on the gi is in conformity with the AJJBWF rules. The use of a non-conforming gi will be prohibited.
- 5.3 Sizes:** The measurements of the gi and their conformity with the AJJBWF rules will be controlled immediately before each fight by Officials appointed by the AJJBWF. The use of a non conforming gi will be prohibited (including the collar thickness shall not excess 1 cm and the width 5 cm)
- 5.4 Color:** Competitors will be required to bring 2 white and blue gi for JJ and 02 blue and green gi for BW. The Color standards for the gi must be in conformity with those in the Sports and Organization. Rules:

6-DRAW

- 6.1 The draw will be conducted in accordance with the Sport and Organization Rules of the AJJBWF. It will be held at the designated Hotel by the Organizing Committee.
- 6.2 Each National Federation must send a delegate to attend the draw; a maximum of two delegates per National Federation will be authorized. After the completion of the draw two sets of the draw lists will be provided to each delegation.
- 6.3 The four medal winners (gold, silver and 2 bronze) of each weight category of the Asian Ju-jitsu Belt Wrestling Federation (male and female) will be “seeded” before the draw, if they compete in the same weight categories.

7-REFEREEING

- 7.1 The Director Referee of respective sports will select the referees for each contest.
- 7.2 Refereeing will be conducted by AJJBWF Continental Referees in accordance with the Refereeing Rules of the AJJBWF
- 7.3 For each contest there will be three referees of nationalities different from those of the competitors.
- 7.4 Referees in case of any difficulties can consult the Director Referee or the designated Chief Referee duly appointed by the Board of AJJBWF. Under no circumstances a competitor or their representatives have any right to appeal against the decisions, and any attempt to approach the Organizing Committee or the AJJBWF Executive Committee in this regard, could result in their exclusion from the Championship.

8-CONTROL OF THE RIGHT TO COMPETE

The control (based on the Sport and Organization Rules of the AJJBWF) will include:

NATIONALITY OF COMPETITORS

Proof of identity will be established by production of a passport or an official documents or its copy from the country for which the competitor has been entered, and the control card will be issued to each competitor. If a competitor has more than one nationality, such competitor can only represent only one country and thereafter may not represent any other country, until after a period of three (3) years has elapsed. If the two federations concerned wish so, they can ask the AJJBWF to reduce or even to suppress this delay in conformity with the Sport and Organization Rules of the AJJBWF and the Olympic Chart. **Only one representative by National Federation must be personally present and submit the start control cards duly completed for all competitors, as well as their identity documents (passport or official identity card). After the control of registrations and signature by the AJJBWF, the start-control card remains with the officials of the AJJBWF for the draw, while the representative receives the Pass, which shall be signed by a representative of the Organizing Committee of the Championship.**

9-INSURANCE

Each National Federation is responsible for his/her competitor (s), [the control of non pregnancy as well as the gender control, is placed under the responsibility of the National Federation], and must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials, including the nominated referees during the Asian Championship. The AJJBWF and the Organizing Committee has no liability whatsoever in nature for any claims of illness, injury or death during the competition or stay in designated city for the championship.

10-DURATION OF CONTESTS

The duration for each contest will be:

FIGHTING - MEN & WOMEN : Four (4) minutes (real time)
in both the sports excluding DUO competition.

11-SYSTEM OF COMPETITION

The system of competition will be elimination system with double repechage, i.e. for all categories the competitors will be divided into two tables by means of a “draw” and an elimination system will be used to produce two finalists.

All competitors defeated by the pool winners of A1, A2, B1 and B2 will take part in the repechages of their respective pools according to the elimination system (subject to less number of entries). Their final contest will be against the loser of the final of each respective other table. The winners (2) of those contests are placed third, the losers (2) are placed fifth. The competitors, who lost their last contest during the repechages against the competitors placed fifth, will then be placed seventh. However, AJJBWF Board has power to decide the new rule or change it according to the circumstances.

12-PARTICULAR RULES FOR WOMEN

Female contestants shall wear under the jacket either, a plain white or off-white tee shirt, with short sleeves, rather strong, long enough to be worn inside the trousers, or a plain white or off-white trousers with short sleeves.

All other regulations must be adhered to.

13-ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

The anti-doping control will include in each category:

13.1- the winner of the category

13.2- one of the three other medal winners

13.3- one of the 5th and 7th placed competitors

As per draw (for 13.2 & 13.3) carried out in accordance with the Anti-doping Rules and the Sport and Organization Rules of the AJJBWF.

- The competitors drawn among the fifth and seventh have to go immediately to the anti-doping control.

- At the end of the medal ceremony, all other competitors summoned in writing by the Physician mandated by the AJJBWF follow the indications leading them to the check station (they have to report to the station one hour after summoned). They are constantly accompanied by persons from the organization from the time they receive their notice until they reach the check station. A person of their choice (team doctor, coach, trainer, delegation head.....) may accompany the competitor. The draw is made during the competition before the start of the finals Block.

14-AWARDS

The organizer shall provide for presentation:

14.1- A certificate of participation for each participant.

14.2- Medals and Certificate of Merit

First place:	Gold medal and Certificate
Second place:	Silver medal and Certificate
Two Third places:	Bronze medal and Certificate
Two Fifth places:	Certificates
Two Seventh places:	Certificates

15-PAYMENT OF FEES BY PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES

National Federation which have not paid their membership fees to the AJJBWF by the required date will automatically be suspended from all activities of the AJJBWF, including participation in the Championships, until full payment is made of all accounts due.

National Federation will have to pay an entry fee of 50 US Dollars for each weight category before the 30th October, 2007 or on arrival to the Organizing Committee.

16-DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES

All entries for competitors must be listed on the enclosed forms and must be forwarded to both of the following addresses:

17-Visas:

In order to ensure the issuance of Visas, each country must to send Annex 2 to the Organizing Committee until September 30, 2007

18- National Flag and Anthem:

Each delegation must bring Two national Flags (120x180 cm) CD/DVD of national Anthem (Short Version)

19- Referees:

All member Countries must ensure that they enter qualified (at least Two) Continental Referees in the Continental Championship or other official event under the décor of AJJBWF. Failure in compliance will cause a penalty of US \$600/- to be payable to AJJBWF in both the sports.

Important:

Those member countries are not in conformity of the Referee rules with AJJBWF, They must avail the opportunity of putting their respective Referees in the 2nd Asian Continental Referee Course and Examination to be held from November 11-18, 2007 at Lahore-Pakistan. Prior to the 2nd Asian Championship 2007. The cost of the Referee course & Exams is US \$ 150/- per participant.
